Please remember to get the full learning, the wisdom of the scripture for the chapter we are in, as in Luke 14, be sure and read the whole chapter so that you can see the events leading up to that scripture and what is going on at that time. I don't care to give just one simple line of text as sometimes it can throw the whole learning of the chapter off, as to what is being taught, so for it to be a true learning experience with the whole truth, be sure and to read the whole chapter. There are space restraints on the devotional/ newsletter Bible Studies. Otherwise I would post the whole chapter for the teaching...the purpose of a teaching is also to encourage you to read the Bible, it takes about a month for something to become a habit, then it becomes a automatic cruise control, you just do it. For we are to meditate on the Word day and night...as for the time, as long as you are keeping Him first and fellowshipping with Him, for He is a jealous God.....part of teaching is to cause the person reading to excel, so that than you can go forth and share.....for we are one body with many parts....God does not discriminate, and He uses all of us, and He does use the foolish to confound the wise.......

Luke 14; verse 1; It occurred one Sabbath, when [Jesus] went for a meal at the house of one of the ruling Pharisees, they they were [engaged in] watching Him [closely].

[..info on a Pharisee] Separatists (Hebrews persahin, from parash, "to separate"). They were probably the successors of the Assideans (i.e., the "pious"), a party that originated in the time of Antiochus Epiphanes in revolt against his heathenizing policy. The first mention of them is in a description by Josephus of the three sects or schools into which the Jews were divided (B.C. 145). The other two sects were the Essenes and the Sadducees. In the time of our Lord they were the popular party (John 7:48). They were extremely accurate and minute in all matters appertaining to the law of Moses (Matthew 9:14; 23:15; Luke 11:39; 18:12). Paul, when brought before the council of Jerusalem, professed himself a Pharisee (Acts 23:6-8; 26:4, 5).

There was much that was sound in their creed, yet their system of religion was a form and nothing more. Theirs was a very lax morality (<u>Matthew 5:20</u>; <u>15:4</u>, 8; <u>23:3</u>, 14, 23, 25; <u>John 8:7</u>). On the first notice of them in the New Testament (<u>Matthew 3:7</u>), they are ranked by our Lord with the Sadducees as a "generation of vipers." They were noted for their self-righteousness and their pride (<u>Matthew 9:11</u>; <u>Luke 7:39</u>; <u>18:11</u>, 12). They were frequently rebuked by our Lord (<u>Matthew 12:39</u>; <u>16:1-4</u>).

From the very beginning of his ministry the Pharisees showed themselves bitter and persistent enemies of our Lord. They could not bear his doctrines, and they sought by every means to destroy his influence among the people.

That is really eye opening seeing how the Pharisees were, and they were always looking and watching Jesus to try and discredit Him, Jesus came to them with the truth, and in so doing was exposing the Pharisees as to who and what they were, they feared Him, so they wanted to get rid of Him.....[sort of running the good thing they had going; the control and in today's language...the hustling]

I really enjoy this chapter; when we are called invited, we should go and recline in the lowest place [be humble, not thinking more highly of yourself than you ought, don't be a snob]; so that when your host comes in, he may say to you, friend go up higher! Then you will be honored in the presence of all who sit [at table] with you. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled (ranked below others who are honored or rewarded), and he who humbles himself (keeps a modest opinion of himself and behaves accordingly) will be exalted (elevated in rank). When you give a dinner or a supper, do not invite your friends or your brothers or your relatives or your wealthy neighbors, lest perhaps they also invite you in return, and so you are paid back. Than Jesus' statement when you give a banquet or a reception, invite the poor, the disabled, the lame and the blind. Than we must pause and remember what Jesus said inMatthew 25: 35;

For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in,

We are not to do anything to draw credit to ourselves, or as one friend put it to be a hero, or to be seen, for when we do that we already have our reward, on earth and that is it, there will not be any other reward, and a treasure is not built in Heaven. Just think if Jesus would have been like some of these people, He asked for nothing in return He met the need and cared for the people with compassion and mercy, and He still does. A Man among men, but above men, Jesus, He came went right into the trenches with us; lived among the people, ate with the people, taught the people, healed the people....He has no boundaries, He is everywhere.
