Unwillingness to forgive is the cause of many losing their souls. In Matthew 18: 21-35 Peter asks Jeus how often must we forgive and Jesus answered; "seventy times seven." Jesus speaks of the unlimited power of faith, and then by the parable of the obedient servant shows them that humility is the groundwork of faith.

We are to pay attention and always be on our guard looking out for one another. If your brother sins solemnly tell him so and reprove him, and if he repents, forgive him. Even if he sins against you seven times in a day, and turns to you seven times and says, I repent, you must forgive him.

Forgiveness sometimes is difficult especially when the offense is traumatic, but forgive anyway, though it is difficult, and NO what they did is not right, but when you forgive them you are taking a step toward healing. Think about this you may be suffering in hate, for ten years for what someone did, but that person is going about their daily duties and has no thought of you, they have blown it off.....so whom is suffering?? That is why you forgive, not because they did something wrong; but that anger and hate will harden your heart, and if you let Him He will heal you. Take the step......

There will be temptations, snares, traps set to entice to sin, they are sure to come, but woe to him by or through whom they come. Be on guard, test the spirits always, use discernment. In case you have not noticed the wolves in sheep's clothing are rampant today, everywhere and in a lot of Churches. I once asked a person if they believed in God but I did not ask if they believed in Jesus. Even satan believes in Jesus, and he knows scripture frontwards and backwards, so if he does than so does his helpers. So test the spirits, use discernment many times a week now I hear how people have been deceived or used, or hurt.....we believe it may be the last days, so be on guard. For that time or hour know man knows, not even Jesus, only God does, but there will be signs. In the case above I found out later the person did believe in God but not Jesus, and I had trusted the person, and I paid with 19 years of my life, so consider that. Satan takes the Word and twists it to deceive us. I talked to a woman sometime back and she told me she had love for someone, not her husband, so I go but that is not God for He will not go against His Word and tell you to go with a married man, and also you are married; oh but the feeling it is love......NO it is lust. Love has a lot more to do with than feelings, and feelings are fickle you cannot trust them. Real Love really is 1 Corin. 13....it is how God loves us and how we are to love.....When ever you come into contact with temptation reach for the Bible and read it pertaining to what you are going through, and in most cases just walk away, involving lust. That ten minutes of feelings will certainly look good in divorce court on your divorce papers, that is not God, He does not tempt, or bring lust He is incapable of it, for He is holy and He is the truth. He also does not bring confusion, that is also the evil one. So always think of that, and put on Your armor and take up your sword. Here is a letter I wrote for the troops on 9/11 concerning the armor, it is written by a mother as a parable....(next page)
