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The vineyard is the nation of Israel (Isaiah 5: 1-7). The vineyard hadn't produced the fruit that God wanted, so He sent prophets to Israel, but the people wouldn't hear them. Finally, he sent His Son, but the people rejected and killed Him. After this, the Gospel was taken to the Gentiles. The Sadducees didn't believe in the resurrection, angels or spirits. They were materialists. The son was always subordinate to the father in Israel's social structure. A father would never call his son "my lord." David was prophesying of His Lord, the Messiah Jesus Christ. For David himself says in [the] Book of Psalms. The Lord said to my Lord, sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet. [Psalm 110: 1] So David calls Him Lord, how then is He his Son? And with all the people listening He said to His disciples. Beware of the scribes, who like to walk about in long robes and love to be saluted [with honor] in places where people congregate and love the front and best seats in the synagogues and places of distinction at feasts. Who make away with and devour widows' houses, and [to cover it up] with pretense make long prayers. They will receive the greater condemnation (heavier sentence, the severer punishment).

Beware of the scribes...who like to go about...or should we say wolves in sheep's clothing? They are rampant today not only in worldly but in our churches. Not only male but females, that person whom is kind, knows scripture, prays and for outward appearances seem's to be a Christian, but things, about them you have a uneasy feeling, or they have bouts of anger, than more and more stuff comes out as you get to know them and it may be a month, two, three, four, six or a year or more...and boom. In the mean time you are a agape Christian; you walk the walk, talk the talk...but you also live it. Again I say to you what ever is in the dark, cannot usually be brought into the light. Think about it, when a person is committing adultery they rarely do it in the day light, when a person breaks in a home they rarely do it in the day light, when a person commits murder they rarely do it in front of someone, when a person steals usually no one is around. So I tell people and also those dating; what ever is in the dark and cannot be brought into the light is usually a lie, not the truth. The truth always comes out it cannot be prevented and all things are revealed in the light....Jesus Christ is the light. Yes, we know all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God and we are to forgive as we were forgiven, the Bible also says we are to be wise and use discernment. If something seem's to good to be true, than it probably is not the truth, very rarely is it the other way. On the prayer line about 3 years ago, I provided some insight to a person broken hearted because the girl he was living with decided that she did not love him, and he did not know what to do. He stated and I really liked her son, felt like he was my son. So I asked him what happened. The living together was one thing and several other things, her x had been calling her and he was not a jealous man, but he had also been meeting her. She could not make up her mind whom she loved. They had a house together, so of course he had to move out. So I go well you are a Christian right, yeah and she went to church to, and I go but you were living together? Well yeah we loved each other. I go yes, but if you are a Christian usually you get married before you have the fringe benefits. Than I stated, I feel worse for the son, and he said why? Than I answered because he has no roots, one guy in one guy out, what do you think this is teaching him to become as a man later? He had not thought about it. I go for kids to be healthy adults they need roots and security that a parent is not going to change like a bicycle wheel can be changed, rules are set up and with each new pretend parent they do not know where they stand because all of a sudden.....whoops the rules changed. Plus kids always think it is their fault. I asked why did you two not get married, oh well we decided living together is the same thing. I go well it isn't you both set yourselves up to fail, if the pressure gets to tuff you can just bail, when something better comes along you can leave....because you have no bonding, no roots, no commitment. I go you know sounds to me like maybe it was not love, but lust. Oh know it is love. So I said than why is she gone, oh well she wanted to see if she loved him still, I go while she was living with you? Yeah he said. This same conversation went on for three months, and no progress. She would call him talk to him a week or so, than be gone. So I go you run around with your guy friends right? Oh yeah I am into sports, I go ok, when you guys talk about things what do you talk about girls, yeah sometimes, and about how you make moves on them right, sometimes he said....I go ok than do you know what the term means, telling someone the truth in 365 different ways (word play, double talk, a lie, manipulation, hustling)? He goes what does that have to do with her....I go she does not know what she wants...she is a player...and I am sorry. I go it is your business. He goes but the son, I want him to have a good life...I go ok call her and see if you can still be a friend as in big brother for him take him fishing, sports. He called, she refused. The point... some things may seem real but they are smoke in your eyes...and some people play games very well...and if you really want something or something is missing in your life, most of the time these people know it in a short amount of time just talking to you, it is called getting their foot in the door...than they nail you. This happens to men and women. Today it is in some churches also, so use discernment , be wise, pray about it and if it does not line up with the Word....beware.....this is a wolf in sheep's clothing much like a Sadducee. Today in the news sometimes we hear it about pastors.....so make sure you really know someone....

Before you start calling them a friend or best friend. How else can you tell? What kind of fruit do they bare, and what kind of people are around them all the time? I only bring this up....because a friend wanted me to warn the people to warn the flocks about the wolves in sheep's clothing. Out of kindness she helped a man in church the same age as one of her sons, she felt sorry for him and he assaulted her. It turned out he had a past history of assault and had been in prison for it, but he said he was a Christian; he knew scripture, prayed, church, Bible studies....than wham. The man is also a pastor's son. She asked me to post a warning to people in the Chapel so I did, within two hours on facebook, six women came forward by private conversation and said they had been abused in church by Christian (supposedly) men. Three different churches. So I just want to say, we believe these are the last days, and the evil one knows his time is short, so there will be attacks, be on your guard and test everything, look for fruit, can they confess Jesus Christ is Lord.....don't be blinded by what you think you may have with them....that goes for male and female....a lot of people go to Church to find a new boyfriend or girlfriend. So what can you do?? If you are single don't go with anyone by yourself, take someone with you as a witness....unless you really, really know the person. In public places with a lot of people is safer. If they are married than ask the spouse to be present, if it is for a business reason take someone with you. Just because you know of someone or met them on line, does not mean you know them as a person, you just know of them. Several hospitals, police stations, schools, martial art's places offer self defense training, and I advise women to take one of the classes, they do not teach knock out drag out's...KO's but they will teach you simple moves to protect your self, and should also be for daughters to and sons. Always be aware of your surroundings, and if you are not comfortable with someone....leave.....Don't ever bring a person into your house, till you are completely sure you have proof that you can trust them. If that person whom you are dating or just a friend has a lot of anger, etc, or likes to grab your arm or leaves black and blue marks on you, or they get furious when you pick up something of theirs, or they want to know whom you talked to every minute of the day....or they time you....or they seem to be controlling..telling you what to do all the time....trying to get rid of your friends and family....than beware.....you will not change them.....just walk away....
