The Women.....Three are named, beside many others, nothing further is known of Susanna, Joanna was wife of Herod's steward, from the king's palace. She belonged to the group of Jesus' closet friends. She was among those at the tomb (Luke 24:10).

Mary Magdalene was the most prominent and outstanding leader among the women. She is named more than any of the others, and usually first (Matthew 27:56, 61, 28:1; Mark 15:40, 47, 16:1, 9; Luke 8:2; 24:10; John 19:25; 20:1, 18). She was the first to whom Jesus appeared after His resurrection. That she was named among those who "ministered of their substance" (3), suggests that she was a woman of some wealth. That she had been healed of "seven demons" (2), is no indication that she was unchaste. Demons caused sickness and disease of various kinds (Mark 5:1-20), but are nowhere connected with human immorality. Unquestionably she was a woman of the of unblemished character. She was NOT the sinful woman of the preceding chapter. It is simply unthinkable that Jesus would accept a common prostitute as the leading woman of His group.

It may be a good thing that we humans among ourselves make a distinction between respectable sins and gross sins, and put a sort of disgrace upon those who are guilty of certain forms of gross sin. The fact that we do may help to save our human society from utter ruin. But to God sin is sin. And it is, no doubt, just as hard for God to forgive our respectable sins as it is for him to forgive those who have brought upon themselves the disgrace of society. For a prostitute to have her sins forgiven and be accepted in the fellowship of the saved, is one thing, but it would be quite a different thing to immediately place such an one as the head of religious work.

Jesus; than gives the parable of the seed; the seed is sown; some fell on along the traveled path and was trodden under foot and the birds of the air ate it up. (the people who have heard then the devil comes and carries away the message out of their hearts, that they may not believe and be saved.) And some seed fell on the rock, and as soon as it sprouted it withered away because it had no moisture. (and those on the rock who when they hear receive and welcome it with joy; but these have no root. They believe for a while, and in time of trial and temptation fall away). And other seed fell in the midst of the thorns, and the thorns grew up with it and choked it off (and as for what fell among the thorns, these are who hear, but as they go on their way they are choked and suffocated with the anxieties and cares and riches and pleasures of life, and their fruit does not ripen come to maturity and perfection). And some seed fell into good soil, and grew up and yielded a crop a hundred times (but as for that seed in the good soil, these are who, hearing the Word, hold it fast in a just and worthy heart, and steadily bring forth fruit with patience). The disciples asked Him the meaning of the parable; He said to them, to you it has been given to know the mysteries and secrets of the kingdom of God but for others they are in parables, so that looking they may not see, and hearing, they may not comprehend. Now the meaning of the parable is this; the seed is the Word of God. No one after he has lighted a lamp covers it with a vessel or puts it under a couch, but he puts it on a lamp stand, that those who come in may see the light. (if a candle when lit, has a cover placed on it with no opening, what does it do? It is snuffed out, fire has to have air to multiply and flame, so if you starve yourself from the Word and do not meditate on the Word, you are starving your spirit, snuffing it out, your spirit is not fed, so than someone comes along and says "hey" let's go bar hopping, and you go gee I don't think so, oh but one beer won't hurt, next thing you know it is the next day and you have spent all night throwing up.....you are starving your spirit out, you have to plant the seed, the Word in you, than when you are offered temptation, and you have been studying the Word, scripture will come to mind, or you will have no peace about the situation, because the Word is in you teaching you; His way, His will. No one puts a lit candle under a couch; what would happen?? The flame would spread and the couch would catch on fire, a real hot seat, you have been feeding your spirit with the Word, but you got careless, sloppy and instead of being on meat you are on milk, you have some knowledge but with every wind of doctrine you are swayed, luke warm. To learn the Word, you have to keep the flame lit, and study, it says to meditate on the Word, day and night...it is for a reason, it feeds your spirit, you gain knowledge and can fight off those temptations and lusts, Ephes. 6: 10-18 the Word of God is a shield of faith, a sword (the Word), salvation, breast plate of righteousness, the belt of truth, and the shoes of peace.....it is our weapon...how can you fight a battle if not prepared?? So even if just 30 mins. A day read the scripture and do a devotional both spouses and also do it with children geared to them. Also pray....what happens when

You don't pray??.....nothing changes. How do you know ole man what you are being taught at church is the truth if you don't read the Word, and study it?? Many people are being misled today by false pastors (wolves in sheep's clothing) and their sermons sound good, the tickling of ears, but the scripture is being twisted, and test the spirits..) I have even witnessed a lot of churches lately that when you ask them about a scripture said, than they start attacking you and say you are in error, or they are so legalistic, there is no human way to obey all they say, than there are the churches that look so good, and scripture is on target the teachings, but they have no missions what so ever, the Bible is specific whom we are to help and what we are to do. I have also witnessed Churches whom again have the scripture correct and the teachings, but the pastor has no morals, you would be surprised how many women are deceived by these pastors, than when the bottom falls out they say well you lead them on, nada, the pastor started it, and sooner or later God will bring it into the light.....I have also met so many people today starving for the Word, to be taught....and guess what....they go to church. (FYI that is why these devotionals are so long, they will also be used for Bible studies in my home, we are literally studying the Books together, chapter by chapter and some of the research takes at the very least two hours and not more than four, but it is what He has called me to do, preach the Word.) **For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. 2 Timothy 4: 3** This is happening today, people hear a good teaching also it does not agree with their life style, so they seek a church that approves of their life styles....


For there is nothing hidden that shall not be disclosed, nor anything secret that shall not be known and come out into the open. Be careful therefore how you listen. For to him who has will more be given and from him who does not have even what he thinks and guesses and supposes that he has will be taken away. It is right there in black and white..those who have spiritual knowledge will more be given, and from him who does not have spiritual knowledge (not learning, studying) even what he thinks and guesses and supposes that he has will be taken away (you don't know the Word, so you are literally being lead a stray). I got into a good discussion with my mentor one time, the last one, about Bibles, he said they were written at fourth grade or fifth grade level, my answer is NO they weren't they were beyond college level, if you have seen the scrolls, and a original first King James you can see the difference. So we sort of challenged each other on this and we were both right; the first Bible's were beyond college level, the one's today are at fourth or fifth grade level....scary huh?? So looks like people studying the Bible is showing us how they are dumbing down education and that is sad...for most of us want to learn, when you quit learning, you have a problem. I am glad the translations are easier to read, it is easier to understand, and I still prefer King James, I also use NIV (though some scripture is missing, and some are saying it was not in the original text/scrolls), I also use the Amplified Bible it is a good teaching, learning Bible with extras, and my newer one is a comparative, it is 4 translations in one.....another good study Bible....so be careful what you pick you want something with ease, but not translated so much into street language that you can not see how it was first translated, I still prefer Psalm 23 in the KJV it sounds funny in the other translations, that is just me though and there are a lot of really good software items now too. Psalm 37

1 Fret not yourself because of evildoers, neither be you envious against the workers of iniquity. Prov 23:17; Prov 24:1;

2 For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb.

3 Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shall you dwell in the land, and truly you shall be fed.

4 Delight yourself also in the LORD: and he shall give you the desires of your heart.

5 Commit your way to the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass. Ps 22:8; Ps 55:22; Prov 16:3; Matt 6:25; Luke 12:22; 1Pet 5:7;

6 And he shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your judgment as the noonday.

7 Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him: fret not yourself because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked devices to pass.

8 Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not yourself in any wise to do evil.

9 For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait on the LORD, they shall inherit the earth.

10 For yet a little while, and the wicked shall not be: yes, you shall diligently consider his place, and it shall not be.

11 But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace. Matt 5:5;

12 The wicked plots against the just, and gnashes on him with his teeth.

13 The LORD shall laugh at him: for he sees that his day is coming.

14 The wicked have drawn out the sword, and have bent their bow, to cast down the poor and needy, and to slay such as be of upright conversation.

15 Their sword shall enter into their own heart, and their bows shall be broken.

16 A little that a righteous man has is better than the riches of many wicked.

17 For the arms of the wicked shall be broken: but the LORD upholds the righteous.

18 The LORD knows the days of the upright: and their inheritance shall be for ever.

19 They shall not be ashamed in the evil time: and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied.

20 But the wicked shall perish, and the enemies of the LORD shall be as the fat of lambs: they shall consume; into smoke shall they consume away.

21 The wicked borrows, and pays not again: but the righteous shows mercy, and gives.

22 For such as be blessed of him shall inherit the earth; and they that be cursed of him shall be cut off.

23 The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delights in his way.

24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholds him with his hand.

25 I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

26 He is ever merciful, and lends; and his seed is blessed.

27 Depart from evil, and do good; and dwell for ever more.

28 For the LORD loves judgment, and forsakes not his saints; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off.

29 The righteous shall inherit the land, and dwell therein for ever.

30 The mouth of the righteous speaks wisdom, and his tongue talks of judgment.

31 The law of his God is in his heart; none of his steps shall slide. Ps 40:8; Isa 51:7;

32 The wicked watches the righteous, and seeks to slay him.

33 The LORD will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged.

34 Wait on the LORD, and keep his way, and he shall exalt you to inherit the land: when the wicked are cut off, you shall see it.

35 I have seen the wicked in great power, and spreading himself like a green bay tree.

36 Yet he passed away, and, see, he was not: yes, I sought him, but he could not be found.

37 Mark the perfect man, and behold the upright: for the end of that man is peace.

38 But the transgressors shall be destroyed together: the end of the wicked shall be cut off.

39 But the salvation of the righteous is of the LORD: he is their strength in the time of trouble.

40 And the LORD shall help them, and deliver them: he shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in him.
