Jesus when teaching taught the people to pray in the format as the Lord's Prayer. Matthew 6 Luke 11 This is a good start, and I add my petition/requests to it. You cannot pray anything that is against God/ the word. (Example you want someone dead or hurt). I pray in agreement with the word and sometimes I pray scripture or as above I will say I claim Matthew 6.

You will note in Matthew 6 the format; we give God; glory, praise. We ask to be forgiven, and bless others. We cannot come to God except through Jesus, the Bible states that clearly.

We make a request in prayer one time; if you pray the same thing everyday you are saying; (we are not to pray in vain repetition, chants, or to be seen) that God does not hear, and He is not the truth. This does not mean we do not pray again for that person, just do not use chants. Faith-When you pray it believe it, and believe it is done; you are stepping out in faith/love. I believe it is done and come to pass. I receive it. Than each day there after give Him glory and praise that it is done and come to pass. Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you with utterance in prayer, to pray as you ought in love. For the commandment is to love one another. Praying is actually a seed, you plant it and watch it grow, and it is sown in love. Prayer is communion with God. First, I would have to ask if you are saved. If not than you need to repent (sinners prayer) there is one on my website (Isn't it time). You do not want anything to hinder your prayers. God hears all prayers, sometimes He does not answer because it is not His will, or what you want may not be for you. God also hears prayers of sinners when they cry out to Him. Why do sometimes people don't get prayers answered; it does not come to pass? Because they don't receive it into their heart, their faith wavers, it is not His will (you have asked amiss, falsely). When we pray sometimes it is answered right that second, or the answer may be several years down the line, or next week. There have been reports of people praying for people, that after that person died that prayed the prayer, it came to pass (I do have a testimony from a pastor's wife on it, it was her mother and she knew what she had been praying for years). I am the result of prayer, being lead to Him. I was not taught in prayer, the Holy Spirit; taught me. When you ask Jesus to come into your life, heart; the Holy Spirit comes into you to help, train, mentor, teach. I also always ask to be able to see and hear everything He is doing throughout the world and universe. You can even pray scripture; Psalm 91, Luke 1:37 are good ones. I am always humble in prayer, for it is not us, but Him that does it. I hope this has answered some of your questions . In your prayers always ask in Jesus' name; every knee must bow, every one; even diseases. When I pray for healing I know that sometimes healing is above this earth; so be careful praying prayer for healing. I state specifically what I want done, good health right here on earth, but if it is their time for Him to take them quickly. Only He knows when it is their time. The first person I prayed for ; laid hands on fell over dead (week later). It was simply that persons time. Prayer is powerful; it can move heaven and earth. If you notice in the NT when people prayed it says; He spoke it, He touched; He called; He asked.

Also if a person has repented; but sinned again, that hinders prayers, the answers. I ask the Holy Spirit to show me anything I need to correct; before I pray.



The scriptures posted are only a few that pertain to the specific areas/items. Remember to keep prayer simple, if you ask everything in your prayer in 5 to 10 mins., and it is complete, than you have prayed. Sometimes I pray for a few minutes, sometimes over an hour, depends on how the Holy Spirit prompts me, how many I am praying for, and I love to pray.....so.. Prayers from people lead me back to the Lord, not the person praying, but God brought me back, some people prayed for me for over 20 years.

To me prayer is communion; liquid moving fire communion, full of passion in love in Him, it is a hot line directly to God, love talk. I do keep a prayer journal, though lately have not kept it up, I like to list what I prayed for, for that person, I do not want to forget them, and when it comes to pass, or not, I note the date. I have been asked a time or two in the past if I had proof my prayer requests come to pass, so I note the prayers and the dates. Am I bragging NO only our Father and His Son heals we don't, He uses us as His hands and feet, and I do believe He uses doctors to, Luke himself was a doctor. Midwives are all through the Bible, also, and so is medication from those days, proof of it and so is infection control. I also have letters from people, some over 20 years old. I just love God and just pray, I am not special, we all are the apple of God's eye. It is best praying in public where two or three involved, that way no one can take credit for the outcome in the wrong way, and the people whom you are praying for cannot come back and give you glory, that is a false god. The one statement that made an impact on me when I came back to the Lord and the statement I have never forgotten, from a mentor pastor is.....don't ever think or feel that you are the only one that loves Jesus...ever...or that your prayers are the only one's heard...or that you are the only one called, or that you are the only one to serve...and I have not ever forgotten it.

Hindrances to prayer are; strife, quarreling, hatred, jealousy and sin, when someone touches in agreement with me or I ask them to agree with me in prayer, I want them also to have it right with the Lord, other wise it hinders the prayer, the flow. It took me some time to pray in public, for I believe in the prayer closet (metaphor, praying in private), but sometimes it is necessary to pray in public, and I have learned the hard way, when a person asks for prayer when I am talking to them I.....S = stop T=to O=obey P=pray (Stop) for I have learned the statements; well I am praying for you, or I will pray for you....fall by the road side, in other words, you get busy with the day, and just plain forget to pray for them, and in my case than working with several different patients, after awhile you can forget which person. I just to joke the lady that does a prayer and a bath....meaning personal care, sometimes I would be so busy that I would pray when I started taking vitals or personal care, used to freak me out because the patients would ask me for prayer when I walked in the door of their room, and they did not even know me. I assume some and believe to have been Holy Spirit prompting them and the rest by word of mouth.

For a good study on prayer...first look up everything Jesus said in category ; as in He spoke it, He commanded it, He touched, authority, He cast out, prayeretc.....it is really eye opening.

Worship, intercession, repentance, surrender, praise and petition are all important elements of prayer. Even as the disciples did, ask God to teach you about these different aspects of prayer and be sure to spend time with him in prayer, daily. Our asking, seeking and knocking must be sincere and we should always be ready to make a deeper commitment to God. When this happens, He will move and send His Holy Spirit to touch each of us in a special way. Ask and believe by faith that God will do something. While you wait for Him to do it, keep thanking Him and offering Him praise.

Realize in prayer that God, hears all prayers....and also know that some are answered instantly, some next day, some week later, some month later, and some month's later, and some year later, and some years later, and some after a person passes away. That is the thing I hear today, people ask for prayer they turn around 5 mins. Later ask you to pray again, same thing, because something did not happen instantly, this is a rush, rush generation and they want it now.....there are NO drive through break through....it is not fast order, it is God's will, God's way, God's timing and remember His ways are higher, and when Your prayer is answered it may not be in the way you think it should be, and sometimes the time is not right, and the other times, there is probably something wrong in the situation. Example I prayed and claimed some land for the church to be built, it did not happen, later I found out that the property though ...excellent ...the house would have had to be completely updated; wiring, plumbing, etc....though it was well maintained, the age of the house it was time to gut it and do it...so it would have been some time to just live there and use it, I could have been paying two house payments plus repairs.
