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Do you think that these Galileans were greater sinners than all the other Galileans because they have suffered in this way? I tell you, No; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish and be lost eternally. Or those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them do you think that they were more guilty offenders than all the others who dwell in Jerusalem? I tell you, No; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish and be lost eternally. And He told them this parable; a certain man had a fig tree, planted in his vineyard, and he came looking for fruit on it, but did not find [any]. So he said to the vine-dresser, see here! For these three years I have come looking for fruit on this fig tree and I find none, Cut it down! Why should it continue also to use up the ground? But he replied to him, leave it alone, sir [just] this one more year, until I dig around and put manure [on the soil].....then perhaps it will bear fruit after this; but if not, you can cut it down and out.

What are the fruits of the spirit ....that was spoke of in the parable??

(For the fruit of the Spirit [is] in all goodness and righteousness and truth;) Ephesians 5: 9

Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Matthew 3:8 Produce fruit in keeping with repentance.

Proverbs 11:30 The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise.

Revelations 2:7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that over cometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

.....so fruit comes from tree's.....right? (meaning if you have repented are saved and being lead by Jesus in a love walk with Him; living it, eating it and breathing it and going forth and there is a change in you, than you should be bearing fruit; love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness).

And the tree of life was in the garden of Eden and is in Revelations ; now read Proverbs 11:30; so if we bear good fruit for the righteous it is a tree of life.....and he who wins souls is wise.....the tree of life is also Jesus Christ so.....we are saved, we learn, we drink.....and manure is placed on us, so that we are more fertile, we will bear fruit (harvesting). Remember we talked about the gospel being compared to seeds; sow/ plant; water/ manure, sprout/ harvest....so if you are not growing and bearing fruit, seek God in the Word and pray and ask if anything is amiss, or if there is anything you need to do. For if God be for us whom can be against us?? If God is in what you are doing you will be bearing fruit, so if you are not than you need to examine what you are doing, go to God, and seek the scripture. Bearing fruit is also how we test the spirits.....no fruit, something is amiss.

When a person is "saved".....than there will be a change...everyone has a before and after story....if they do not ....than they probably are not saved or they think they are but they keep doing what they were doing as living in the worldly ways, and it is evident there will be no change in them, even when convicted they still do what they want to do....they believe God was made for them, instead of them being made for God, and to give Him glory. To me they think God is a fairy tale, they know the story, but they do not believe it, so they go along with it.....in front of the Christian people. Jesus; did say we can not put new cloth in old wine cloths, for the cloth will pull away the old from the new.( they went back to their old ways, instead of staying in the new life, they fall away)

Did you know that a person of worldly ways, not saved, cannot confess that; "Jesus Christ is Lord??"

This is true and it is also how we test the spirits also. Example; on the website I used to give an award to good Christian websites, and good family oriented sites....it was a silver cross , and also there was a gold one, to post on their website as marking it as a good, clean Christian site, family friendly. A woman approached me and demanded one of the crosses, I went to her website, to confirm/affirm it as being Christian with teachings and etc. When I went to the site; she had spiritual teachings (this is why we need to make sure their defining of spiritual is Christian) it contained new age teachings, and several others from other cultures and it had one that was the white light (wiccan), so I emailed her to ask her to explain what some of the stuff was to define them and she said the white light is wiccan, but not witch craft, and

I emailed back but wiccan is witch craft, so she than said well it involves good white light, good witches. So I asked so why do you want a cross?? She replied something like well we are spiritual. So I replied, ok, just; confess to me that Jesus Christ is Lord, and I will gladly give you a cross for your spiritual website...She got angry and said, there are many spiritual ways to get to heaven many avenues, besides one way, she said we believe in God, too. I go well confess to me that Jesus Christ is Lord. She got really angry and emailed for awhile than quit.....she could not confess it.

Test the spirits; use discernment, check their fruit (if they are not walking in it, practicing it, living in it, if they are drunk all the time, doing drugs, living with some one; than ask yourself are they truly saved? If your answer is NO than they aren't). On the prayer lines I used to get requests for prayer for their relationship, live in one's, to be healed and restored. So reading what they posted I go; so you have children, your relationship broke up, tell me were you or are you married? They would say NO, but I want my relationship back, and I would respond I cannot pray for that, that would be going against God's Word, and in essence slapping Him in the face, and if I had of went along with it, than I would be accountable to God for not counseling them in love, to correct the situation and not in condemnation. I would always say I am not a judge or a miniature Holy Spirit, but this is against God and I will not do as you ask. Than I would say the guy left, right? They would respond with well yeah. I felt sorry for them, compassion, but than I would say; if the guy really loved you, and said he was a Christian he would not ask you to move in, he would instead have asked you to marry him, he would respect you. The way you have it now in your life, there is No marriage bond, so he can leave whenever he wants, and your kids have NO roots, they don't know where they stand so a family bond is not formed, it would always be tempory and not permanent. So than I would say I will pray for you, but I cannot pray what you request. Than they would also tell me they were attending church. I kept thinking what in the world are the pastors teaching in that church.....? Eye opening huh? We have almost two generations of people that know nothing about God, our Lord Jesus, starting from the late 50's early 60's, the me generation. Some good came out of the 60's, but it was also the beginning of a great down fall. So, a lot of people really just do not know.

When Jesus comes back to claim His throne, as He said some will knock on the door; and He will say to them, I never knew you.....that day will be a day of joy, love for some and weeping and gnashing of teeth for others. There will be some in church today whom will not be there, and there will be some there that we thought would not be there that are. There will be some people in your life that you are witnessing to, that you will have to just walk away from. God calls them is drawing them and you know it, but they kept refusing Him, denying Him


.....but if not...you can cut it down and out.....if God is calling them and they keep refusing Him, than He will give them the right to go straight to hell.....that is eye opening to.....and I have had the Holy Spirit tell me to quit praying for some people, He draws, offers, they refuse...and He offers and offers and some He let's go. The people that the Holy Spirit told me to not pray for, I was hindering the process in how I prayed, and God was trying to do a work in them, I had prayed for them to be delivered and situation changed He was working in them to walk through, so in hindering they were not growing and His purpose is not fulfilled. So when we pray we have to step back and let God be God, He knows what He is doing.....and I can say when I quit praying and let God be God, that one of the person's was lead to Jesus Christ just before they passed away. His ways are higher and sometimes we think we know how He will do something, but we don't, because He knows their heart, and He knows how to bring it about, to happen, most of the time we don't or it was done in a completely different way than we thought it would be done. So in those cases, I pray and cast the care on Him, and keep my cotton picking hands out of it.....So sometimes what we pray for maybe be hindering the person or stopping the flow, and I would assume also that we don't know all sides of the story, but God does know, for nothing is hidden from Him. For all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God, the only exception is Jesus Christ, He was/is sin free.....
