On the day of Pentecost, the fiery tongues and the roaring as of a mighty wind brought together the astonished crowds. This gave Peter a large audience for his first public proclamation of the Gospel. Apparently some days had passed (2:46-47). The crowds that had come for the Feast of Pentecost returned home, and the city had quieted down. The apostles kept busy instructing the believers and doing miraculous signs (2:42-47), and a lame man, a familiar sight to the whole city, who sat in the temple gate every day to beg, is healed by Peter and John—and the city is all a stir once again. In front of the amazed crowds, Peter attributes the healing to the power of the risen Christ. As Peter tells the Gospel story again, the number of believers increases to 5000 (4:4). (Halley's Bible Handbook; 2000; Page 727; notes and commentary)

"The blessed Holy Spirit awaits to be honored. He will honor Christ as we honor Christ. He waits—and if we will throw open our heart to Him, a new sun will rise on us. I know this by personal experience, If there is anything that God has done through me, it dates back to that solemn, awful, wondrous hour when the Light that never was on land or sea, the Light that lighteth every man that cometh into the world, flashed in on my darkness. "I do not believe in a repetition of Pentecost, but I do believe in a perpetuation of Pentecost—and there is a vast difference between the two. I want to try to discover with you the abiding elements of Pentecost as described in the book of Acts. What came and stayed? What came and went? Now, as I said, I do not believe that Pentecost is to be repeated, but I do believe it is to be perpetuated. I believe that Pentecost did not come and go but that Pentecost came and stayed. You and I are living in the midst of it, if we only knew it. It was true of Pentecost, as it is of all religious experience, that there were elements that were external—so they were variable. God doesn't care very much for the external. We ought to let the Holy Ghost teach us that God places little emphasis on the external aspects. Then, there are the elements which are internal and of the Spirit—they are permanent, and they are always about the same. Then there are elements which are incidental and so are of relative importance. I would not say that they are not important, but I say that they are not critically important. Then, of course, there are elements that are fundamental and so are of vital importance."

You do not need to get frustrated trying to find God. Just learn to wait on Him and pray, "God, reveal Yourself to me; manifest Your presence to me." God manifests, His presence in many ways. Sometimes we cannot see Him but, as with the wind, we can see the work He does in us. If I am weary, tired, worn-out, frustrated, or bothered about something, and I become refreshed after spending time with God, than I know that the "wind" of the Lord has blown upon me....."
