James, the brother of John, one of the three disciples who constituted Jesus' inner circle, was the first of the Twelve to die (A.D. 44). Another James, the brother of Jesus, came to be recognized as the leading bishop of Jerusalem.

When Herod imprisoned Peter, the church earnestly prayed to God for him. God Himself took a hand: He delivered Peter (v 7) and struck down Herod (v. 23). This Herod was not the Herod who had killed John the Baptist and mocked Christ.

This King Herod is Herod Agrippa, the First. He was half-Jewish so he often tried to ingratiate himself with Jews. James the one that died was one of the sons of Zebedee. The word Easter is the King James translation of the word Passover (vv. 3-4). The Easter holiday originated as a pagan holiday featuring colored eggs to celebrate the new beginnings of spring (fertility). One chain was customary but Peter was under double guard. The angel hit Peter on the side to awaken him (vv. 6-7). Peter thought he was dreaming or seeing a vision. Peter suddenly realized he was indeed awake and had actually been freed from prison by the angel. John Mark wrote the Gospel of Mark. He was the nephew of Barnabas and went on the missionary journey with Paul and Barnabas (v. 12). God delivered Peter at this time because He still had work for Peter to do (v. 17).

(v. 5) So Peter was kept in prison, but **fervent prayer** for him was persistently made to God by the Church (assembly). (v. 12) When he at a glance, became aware of this [comprehending all the elements of the case], he went to the house of Mary the mother of John, whose surname was Mark where a large number were **assembled together and were praying**. They all were praying for Peter. Prayer is a first resort not a last resort. I am so amazed people going through, than they will call me or ask me; "I have tried everything, would you now pray for me?" James 4: 2-3....2 You lust, and have not: you kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: you fight and war, yet you have not, because you ask not. 3 You ask, and receive not, because you ask amiss, that you may consume it on your lusts. Matt 20:22; Rom 8:26;.....We are to ask....so we pray first, so get into a good habit of it. Matthew 6: 5-15 and Luke 11: 1-4 are a sample of prayer. I am also amazed people that say but I don't know how to pray, well I understand that, but you just talk to him and those sets of scripture are the format for prayer; both the Lord's Prayer, and we always ask in Jesus' name.

6 Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes to the Father, but by me. Heb 9:8; John 1:17; John 1:4; John 11:25; John 10:9 **John 14:6**

5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; John 17:3; Rom 3:30; Gal 3:19; Heb 9:15 **1 Tim. 2:5**

Jesus; intercedes for us, He is Lord, the King of kings, the Lord of lords, the Priest of priests...sometimes I think people just say He is Lord.....NO.....HE IS LORD it is not just a saying He is the Lord, the only one and every knee will bow to Him.....everyone no exceptions.....

Prayer is liquid moving fire....communion with God, a direct line to God, a hot line, love talk. He knows what we need before we ask, but He wants us to ask. The most powerful prayers; the difference is.....you pray in love. Agape love. I also pray a lot of scripture I put it right in the prayer. His ways are higher, He is above us, not just a name, all powerful.

8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, said the LORD. 9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Isaiah 55 : 8-9

11 So shall my word be that goes forth out of my mouth: it shall not return to me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

Isaiah 55 : 11

God's Word is true, for He cannot lie, He is incapable of it....whatever He says is...and everything you are going through your answers are in ScripturePray....meditate on the Word/read it.....look up Scriptures for what you are going through.....even write them down and say them, sometimes I repeat them through the day. He sends His Word out, it cannot come back empty or void, it accomplishes exactly what He sent it out for, it will not come back empty or void. He is seldom early, but never late, but always just in time. What He says is true He does always provide a way out, you may not like the way out, sometimes it is going through, but He is right there with you going through it with you. Well why doesn't He just fix it right now?? He wants us to grow, He is shaping us as on the potters wheel shaping a pot...He does have a purpose, sometimes I did not see the purpose until it was done the trial but there is one.....so keep praying.....


God draws people, and leads them to Him to be redeemed, sometimes He uses us, to plant the seed, or pray for them, but He calls them, we don't.....

Read it, Pray it, Meditate on it, and be expecting.....


