14 Now about the middle of the feast Jesus went up into the temple, and taught. 15 And the Jews marveled, saying, How knows this man letters, having never learned?

16 Jesus answered them, and said, My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me. John 3:11; John 8:28; John 12:49; John 14:10; John 14:24; 17 If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself. 18 He that speaks of himself seeks his own glory: but he that seeks his glory that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him

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Bible Studies

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Rejection....is not easy...note that Jesus was rejected by His brothers and I presume sisters.....the disciples deserted Him, the people rejected Him (for He preached the true Word and they did not want anyone messing up what they were doing and had in place).....Jesus; spoke the truth, so much truth that the people feared Him, He was different told them simply the truth, and taught them about the living God, still they rejected Him. When people reject you do not think it strange for they rejected Jesus.....He went first.....they are not rejecting you they are rejecting Jesus.....some of the loved one's in your family will reject you, sometimes even spouses, your parents, your children and even your friends.....do not fear.....God will give you more friends, and God will also clean the driftwood or deadwood out of your life.....God will use it to His good and He never will leave you or forsake you, and sometimes all you will have is just Him....it is in these times we draw closer to the Lord...and you will gain a closer love walk with Him. His cup is coming around to you, can you drink from it?? You are being refined.....as a potter with a pot on the wheel He shapes us just how He wants us....and sometimes it can hurt....and usually just before you go to another blessing...there will be attacks before a break through....new level new devil.....if the devil is not trying something than you most likely are not a threat to him.....

The Jewish Feast of Tabernacles was drawing near (October), a year and half since He had been there, six months before His death. On His previous visit He had healed a man on the Sabbath, and announced to the rulers that He was the Son of God (John 5:18), for which they laid plans to kill Him. He remained away during the intervening Passover (John 6:4). But now His work was drawing toward a close, and He again went to the capital of His nation to further present His claim that He was sent from God. The time for His death was not yet fully come. Knowing their plan to kill Him, He made the journey incognito, till He appeared in the midst of the Temple multitudes..Then He opened His address by referring to their plot to kill Him (7: 19-23).

When the Feast was already half over, Jesus went up into the temple [court] and began to teach. The Jews were astonished. **They said; How is it that this Man has learning [is so versed in the sacred Scriptures and in theology] when He has never studied? Jesus answered them by saying; My teaching is not My own, but His who sent Me. If any man desires to do His will (God's pleasure), he will know (have the needed illumination to recognize, and can tell for himself) whether the teaching is from God or whether I am speaking from Myself and of My own accord and on My own authority. He who speaks on his own authority seeks to win honor for himself [He whose teaching originates with himself seeks his own glory] But He Who seeks His glory and is eager for the honor of Him Who sent Him. He is true, and there is no unrighteousness or falsehood or deception in Him. (This is why it is so important to study the Bible...daily...if you do not know what the Bible says than you can be fooled. This is why discernment is so important....we are to test the spirits....always. Today, the wolves in sheep's clothing are rampant be aware, be prepared....I was listing to one pastor here awhile back, and it was so subtle the errors that I almost did not catch it..and I was so surprised. Some of the wolves know scripture frontwards and backwards, but they will throw a twist into the meaning or not mention a word here or there....some will act totally Christian but as time goes on it will come out into the light, for what does the darkness have to do with the light? So I always say anything that is done in the dark usually cannot be brought into the light and if anything has to be hidden it is not the truth. I was also listening to another pastor that I had some respect for and a lot of people follow.....and that pastor had Trump on their program.....Trump and another man were selling a book on fiancés, and kept saying a higher power, but did not mention God or Jesus at all, but yet the other man whom was a co author in the introduction said they were Christian, he also did not mention God or Jesus....they were not telling but selling...the pastor, I was just floored I thought you sold out, Trump has a lot of power and this pastor bowed to it, and I thought I wonder how much he gave.....Than come to find out later that this pastor was also living in a townhouse/apt. in Trump property....I thought know way.....I mention the circumstance not the pastor, as a warning be careful whom and what you are listening to.....If a ministry/church/pastor has to compromise for a donation than I would say that is not from God. Any offering/tithe/donation that comes with strings attached as in you will do this....for this amount that is not God either. As Pastor Chuck Smith says and I agree with...God is not broke....He owns everything...and created it....where God guides He truly provides....and if God is not in it..if He is not there.....than turn and walk away....don't know about you but if God is not in it....I don't want it.....The sad thing about the circumstance I just mentioned is that pastor spent years building their integrity, creditability as a servant /pastor of God....in 30 mins. time it was destroyed....some people listening would not know and accept it, simply because they do not know the Word. We cannot charge for the Word, it is freely given....the pastors/servants teaching the Word are to be supported...we are to give joyfully to God....and in gladness....)**

Zech. 4:6 Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This [is] the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.

1 Corinthians 9:14 In the same way, the Lord has commanded that those who preach the gospel should receive their living from the gospel.

2 Timothy 4:2 Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage--with great patience and careful instruction.

Be aware of what you are being taught and go to the Bible to make sure it is correct. If you do not know your Churches beliefs, doctrine than I encourage you to read it or ask them.....you may be surprised...I have been a time or to. Be wise use discernment...and wisdom and always test the spirits....

Did not Moses give you the Law? And yet not one of you keeps the Law. [If that is the truth] why do you seek to kill Me [for not keeping it]? The crowd answered Him. You are possessed by a demon! [You are raving!] Who seeks to kill You?

Only scholars could speak Hebrew, yet Jesus, who didn't have any formal education, was speaking Hebrew. In those days a teacher would sit and the people would stand (John 8 : 2) A herald, an evangelist to the people would stand and the people would sit. Here Jesus is standing, heralding a glorious new age and proclaiming the simple Gospel.

(38) He who believes in Me [who cleaves to and trusts in and relies on Me] as the Scripture has said. From his innermost being shall flow [continuously] springs and rivers of living water.

This literally means, "there shall gush forth torrents of living water." Jesus was describing how the Holy Spirit would flow from our lives. The Holy Spirit could n't come upon the disciples until Jesus had ascended into heaven and was glorified. The descent of the Holy Spirit was proof of Christ's ascension and glorification (Acts 2:32-33)

(40) Listening to those words, some of the multitude said. This is certainly and beyond doubt the Prophet! [Deut. 18:15, 18; John 1:21; 6:14; Acts 3:22]

(41) Others said, This is the Christ (the Messiah,, Anointed One)! But some said, What? Does the Christ come out of Galilee?

(43) So there arose a division and dissension among the people concerning Him.

(44) Some of them wanted to arrest Him, but no one [ventured and] laid hands on Him.

Note in John 7:37-39 that Jesus did not say that rivers of living water will flow once in a while from those who believe in Him. He said these rivers of living water will flow continuously. That living water is the Holy Spirit. In this passage, Jesus talks about the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, which we have received if we have accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior; the Person and the power of the Holy Spirit in us.
