9 Now when they heard this, they began to drift away one at a time, starting with the older ones, until Jesus was left alone with the woman standing before him. 10 Jesus stood up straight and said to her, “Woman, where are they? Did no one condemn you?” 11 She replied, “No one, Lord.” And Jesus said, “I do not condemn you either. Go, and from now on do not sin any more.”]] John 5:14;

There are three different instances of Jesus' dealing with women who had made a mistake. This one; the sinful woman of Luke 7: 36-50; and the Samaritan Woman (John 4: 18). In all three Jesus was exceedingly considerate. The language of verse 7 may imply that Jesus knew that the men who were accusing the woman were themselves guilty of the very thing of which they accused her. Usually in that day if one was accused of adultery the man and woman both were put in the pit and stoned, note that only the woman was accused and present...so we don't know it is not recorded but can speculate that the man knew someone in authority or he ran off, she obviously did sin...because Jesus said..."I do not condemn you either. Go on your way and from now on sin no more." Other wise from some of the studies I have done from the Jewish perspective sometimes if a husband wanted to be free from a wife, sometimes they would accuse them of adultery to have them stoned to death. Even though as noted by Jesus that His conversation on marriage it was because of the men's hardened hearts that Moses suffered to write a bill of divorcement and to put her away.....

And they said, Moses suffered to write a bill of divorcement, and to put [her] away. Mark 10:4

If a man marries a woman who becomes displeasing to him because he finds something indecent about her, and he writes her a certificate of divorce, gives it to her and sends her from his house, Deuteronomy 24:1

"It has been said, 'Anyone who divorces his wife must give her a certificate of divorce.' Matthew 5:31

In those times woman very rarely were allowed to submit a divorce from a husband, usually only husband's were heard....

Women were considered an asset of property or to combine two families for political power. The marriages were arranged sometimes at birth. Women had no voice in government, and most were not allowed to have a education, unless of course a queen or wealthy family. They were to be covered from head to toe, as the belief was that all women caused the sin. Women walked several paces behind the husband. They were to sit down shut up, be seen and not heard. They were not allowed to speak in the Temples. It was legal to beat a woman whenever the husband pleased. Today, this is still practiced in a lot of countries. The study was quite interesting, I will post it for every one to read someday on the web site. The women were not responsible for spiritual/religion training, the males were, when a daughter was at home before marriage her father taught her, when she married the husband took over the training for the wife and children, if a woman had any knowledge it was usually taught to her by the husband, even self defense, as the countries were always in a battle or to protect themselves. Women usually had to have an escort as a witness in public they were very rarely allowed out by themselves. Even the Queens could not speak to the Kings unless they had permission. There is one female warrior noted in the Bible that was Deborah, she was also a Queen, which means she had a education, undoubtedly to rule, she was also a prophetess. In history recording and in family genealogy women were rarely listed, the males were as the family name. It was not until the late 60's that a woman was allowed to list just one name if widowed or divorced if married more than once a woman had to list all her married names as her legal signature in foreign countries even today in some this is still so, or when named they bear their given name, than mothers last name than father's last name, this is how they tracked the family history in some countries. To me it is more eye opening in the fact that before the Bible was written the Word was sang in songs, or by story tellers. When I think how Jesus helped the women noted above, and how Mary sat at His feet and was taught, it tells me just how awesome our Lord is...We note there was no condemnation of the woman caught in adultery... or the woman at the well that was not married, for all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God..and Jesus said; go and sin no more.....Jesus is compassionate. For that day eye opening for if a male spoke to a woman, in most cases it was illegal without a witness or escort. For God created all male and female, and for Adam God found no one comparable to Adam so He created Eve from Adam's rib. Woman came from man, and man comes from woman.

In those days there was active discrimination against women. Christianity has freed women and set them on equal footing, with men before God. (Galatians 3:28) (Chuck Smith; New Testament Study Guide; 2005; page 44)

Jesus did not come to condemn but to save ( John 3:17-18; Romans 8:1-4). Jesus categorical and amazing statements about Himself infuriated the rulers, and they attempted to mob him (59). Jesus is actually using the name of God, " I AM." Jesus made other claims for himself approximating Deity.

Names and Titles applied by the Scripture to Christ. The Christ, The Messiah, Saviour, Redeemer, Wonderful Counselor, Faithful Witness, The Word of God, The Truth, The Light of the World, The Way, The Good Shepherd, Mediator, Deliverer, The Great High Priest, The Author and Perfector of our Faith, The Captain of our Salvation, Our Advocate, The Son of God, The Son of Man, God, The Holy One of God, Only Begotten Son, Mighty God, The Image of God, Everlasting Father, Lord, Lord of All, Lord of Glory, Lord of Lords, Blessed and Only Potentate, King of Israel, King of Kings, Ruler of the Kings of the Earth, Prince of Life, Prince of Peace, The Son of David, The Branch, David, Root and Offspring of David, The Bright and Morning Star, Immanuel, The Second Adam, The Lamb of God, The Lion of the

(33) They answered Him, We are Abraham's offspring (descendants) and have never been in bondage to anybody. What do You mean by saying. You will be set free?(These are the unbelieving Jews who are answering Jesus. In reality, they were under Roman rule, but they would not acknowledge it. God has place a beautiful spirit of strength, independence, and nationalism in the Jews.)

(43-44) Why do you misunderstand what I say? It is because you are unable to hear what I am saying [ You cannot bear to listen to My message; your ears are shut to My teaching.] 44. You are of your father, the devil, and it is your will to practice the lusts and gratify the desires [which are characteristic] of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a falsehood, he speaks what is natural to him, for he is a liar [himself] and the father of lies and of all that is false. (The desire of their father Satan, was to destroy Jesus.)

(56) Your forefather Abraham was extremely happy at the hope and prospect of seeing My day (My incarnation); and he did see it and was delighted. [ Hebrews 11:13] (There are two different instances when Abraham may have seen Jesus; as Melchizedek (Genesis 14:18; Psalm 110:4; Hebrews 5-7) and while Abraham was interceding (Genesis 18). These manifestations of God are called theophanies. (58) I AM is the name of the eternal God. (New Testament Study Guide; Chuck Smith; 2005; page 44)

a time to keep, and a time to throw away;


