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The verses that go with us as we near the valley of the shadow, Jesus, as a master workman, is preparing the heavenly palace for the glorious day when he will receive His Bride, the elect of all the ages, unto Himself, but the Bride also needs to be made ready. The Church must be gathered, nurtured and perfected, to be made fit for the mansions of God. The people, as well as the place must be prepared. As Jesus departs to make ready the eternal home, He promises to send the Holy Spirit to train, comfort, and lead the saints on the homeward way.

Peter was to fail, Jesus went on to say in this verse, " Let not your heart be troubled."(1) God cannot be disappointed in our failures, because He knows what is in us. We as people expect more out of ourselves and become discouraged.

Mansions literally means abiding places. Jesus throughout these verses promises to come again. Jesus rules out every other religious system. He isn't a way but the way, the only way to the Father. Jesus was a perfect witness of the Father, that He could make this claim. The works of Christ were also the proof of His origin. Greater works, could possibly be greater in number, Jesus was going to the Father, the Holy Spirit was to descend and would touch lives throughout the world.

(14) I will grant [ I Myself will do for you ] whatever you shall ask in My Name [as presenting all that I AM] This verse is a promise in prayer. The purpose of prayer is to get God's will done, not our own. (15) If you [really] love Me, you will keep (obey) My commands. Our proof of love is obedience to the command of Christ.

God has given us the Holy Spirit to enable us to do His work. The Greek word is parakletos, one called a long-side to help. We can have a twofold relationship with the Holy Spirit. (1) With you in the Greek is para. Prior to conversion, the Holy Spirit convicted you of sin and drew you with loving kindness to Jesus. (2) When you open the door to Jesus the Holy Spirit comes in and begins to dwell in you. A further relationship a person can have with the Holy Spirit is upon or over you. This is where the Holy Spirit flows out of your life like a torrent of living water.

(18) I will not leave you as orphans [ comfortless, desolate, bereaved, forlorn, helpless]; I will come [back] to you. (19) Just a little while now, and the world will not see Me any more, but you will see Me; because I live, you will live also.. (20) At that time [ when that day comes ] you will know [ for yourselves ] that I am in My Father, and you [ are ] in Me, and I [am] in you. ( They saw Him after He rose from the dead. The resurrection of Jesus Christ gives us living hope for eternal life; it's the affirmation that all Jesus said is true. ) (21) The person who has My commands and keeps them is the one who [really] loves Me; and whoever [really] loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I [too] will love him and will show (reveal, manifest) Myself to him [ I will let Myself be clearly seen by him and make Myself real to him.] ( Possessing the commandments but not keeping them condemns a man. If you love the Lord and prove it by obedience, God will manifest Himself to you.)

(23) Abode is the same as abiding places in John 14:2. God can only dwell in an atmosphere of love. (26) Is an illustration of the Trinity. The Holy Spirit is promised to be the teacher. If you feed on the Word of God, the Holy Spirit will bring it to your remembrance when it is needed. (27) Peace I leave with you; My [own] peace I now give and bequeath to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. [ Stop allowing yourselves to be agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.] ( This is more than peace with God. We can have the same peace of God that Jesus had.) (28) The Father was greater than Jesus at that time, because of Christ's limitations with His body of flesh. We should not be troubled when Christians die, because they go to the Father and receive a new body from Him. (29) And now I have told you [this] before it occurs, so that when it does take place you may believe and have faith in and rely on Me. ( Jesus shows us that prophecy proves that He speaks the truth.)

(30) Prince of this world, refers to Satan. This world is currently under the power and authority of Satan. We shouldn't blame God for tragedies in this world. (31) God's commandment to Christ was that He demonstrate His love by dying for this world.



15 You delivered your people by your strength –  
the children of Jacob and Joseph. (Selah)  
16 The waters saw you, O God,  
the waters saw you and trembled.  
Yes, the depths of the sea shook with fear. Exod 14:21;  
17 The clouds poured down rain;
