1 Now¹ when the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. Lev 23:15; Deut 16:9; Acts 1:14; 2 Suddenly¹ a sound² like a violent wind blowing³ came from heaven⁴ and filled the entire house where they were sitting. 3 And tongues spreading out like a fire¹ appeared to them and came to rest on each one of them. 4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit, and they began to speak in other languages as the Spirit enabled them. Matt 3:11; Mark 1:8; Luke 3:16; John 14:26; John 15:26; John 16:13; Acts 11:15; Acts 19:6; Mark 16:17; Acts 10:46; 5 Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven residing in Jerusalem. 6 When this sound occurred, a crowd gathered and was in confusion, because each one heard them speaking in his own language. 7 Completely baffled, they said, “Aren’t all these who are speaking Galileans? 8 And how is it that each one of us hears them in our own native language? 9 Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and the province of Asia, 10 Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, 11 both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabs – we hear them speaking in our own languages about the great deeds God has done!” 12 All were astounded and greatly confused, saying to one another, “What does this mean?” 13 But others jeered at the speakers, saying, “They are drunk on new wine!”

(13)verse; I laugh every time when I read that verse, when the Holy Spirit came into me, the baptism of the Holy Spirit, I felt like that, and I could not quit laughing....so much love and joy and peace..... To me speaking in tongues is speaking unto the Holy Spirit, and I also believe it means utterance in foreign languages....when the need arises, according to the Holy Spirit. Though I do pray in tongues, and I have woken up from sleep praying in tongues....someone whom the Holy Spirit had placed across my spirit. Have you ever been, doing something in your day, and you will get a urge to pray for someone? That is the Holy Spirit.....have you ever done something and felt great peace about it.....how about a warning not to do that or go there.....or a warning you know that you are not to do that (conviction).....how about when you read a section of scripture over and over and finally a light comes on and you understand it? All that is the Holy Spirit and much more.....he delivers messages, does teaching in us.....He does not bring temptation, lust or condemnation....when people tell me I am so in love with such and such but you know I am married.....that is not God....so when people mention those three things, than you should test them and You should anyway, you would be surprised how many false non Christian people are in churches, so always test the spirits.....just because they know scripture frontwards, and backwards does not mean anything, Satan knows the Bible frontwards and backwards also....sometimes he will twist one word.....For instance I have studied Calvary Chapels for almost 6 years now, testing the spirits....though they were testing me also, which is anyone's right, and you should do so, we are to be wise stewards/servants. We are very picky about whom we associate with.....as I made the statement and in the beginning; everything has to be completely transparent, pure....that nothing is seen there but.....God, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, the Word and agape love.....and I do not believe any Church has it 100% right, it will not be until Jesus takes the throne, than we will have all the answers and all the questions will be answered that we wonder about.....studying the Holy Spirit is a good study....so dig in.....one of the most extensive studies I have read on the Holy Spirit, I believe it is 5 parts, is by Charles Stanley.....and the one by Bob Coy....just go to their website archives/library and key in Holy Spirit. Bob Coy also did a excellent one on Prayer, and Chuck Smith. What is interesting to me as I have read some sermons of pastors from the past some a hundred years old, and you can still feel the Holy Spirit in the sermons, it is real eye opening and makes you just feel the awe of God....and how He inspired the Bible to be written but also you can feel the Holy Spirit in many other writings written....some of those writings so anointed that you get those goose bumps.....

Verse (6)...And when this sound was heard the multitude came together and they were astonished and bewildered because each one heard them [the apostles] speaking in his own [particular] dialect. (I had this happen on occasion in a Bible study I was doing in a assisted living, there was a 92 year old woman whom had a desire to just hear the Word, the problem was she was deaf and blind, but after one Bible study she goes what Bible are you teaching out of, what translation, I go King James, and some as a comparative simpler language of NIV, she understood and heard everything I spoke, because she asked questions about the teaching, she was there almost every Bible study. So the Lord was fulfilling her heart's desire. Another lady their 94 also just wanted to hear the Word, she told me the man she married back in those days, would not allow her or the kids to go to church and they lived so far out in the country they could not go or walk her husband had died some time before that, so she went to Church and Bible studies whenever she could.....she rode around on a scooter because she could not walk. That is the difference today some other people will cuss in your face when you start talking about the Word or Jesus...) (7) and they were besides themselves, because they heard them talking in their own dialect, language they were amazed and puzzled and bewildered....and still others said they were drunk on wine. (14) Peter standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them. You Jews and all you residents of Jerusalem, let this be [explained] to you so that you will know and understand, listen closely to what I have to say. (15) for these men are not drunk as you imagine, for it is [only] the third hour (about 9:00 am) of the day. (16) But [instead] this is [the beginning of] what was spoken through the prophet Joel. (17) And it shall come to pass in the last days, God declares, that I will pour out of My Spirit upon all mankind, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy [telling for the divine counsels] and your young men shall see visions (divinely granted appearances), and your old men shall dream [divinely suggested] dreams (18) Yes, and on My menservants also and on My maid servants in those days I will pour out of My Spirit, and they shall prophesy [telling forth the divine counsels and predicting future events pertaining especially to God's Kingdom]. (I believe this is happening today, when I look at some of the sound churches there is a mighty move, Calvary Chapel is one of them....do not discount yourself by thinking that God could not possibly use you in Acts 2:17,18 God speaks of pouring out His Spirit on all mankind— menservants, maidservants, sons , and daughters. Joel 2:28, 29 first prophesied these words, and Peter repeats them here in Acts). (19) And I will show wonders in the sky above and signs on the earth beneath, blood and fire and smoking vapor. (the question is.....are YOU ready??)

God's Word must be the basis for our faith and practice. Experience alone is not a solid basis for our faith. The events described in Joel are to take place in the last times just prior to the return of Jesus Christ.

Therefore, we believe that the gifts of the Spirit are for the Church until Christ returns.(23) God sent Jesus to die for us. The resurrection of Christ is the heart of the Gospel message. When Jesus died, His soul went into hell (hades) for three days and three nights. He preached to the captives there (Matthew 12:40; Isaiah 61:1; 1 Peter 3:18-19). (28) 1 Corinthians 13:12. (37) This was the first message preached under the anointing of the Holy Spirit, where men's hearts were convicted ("pricked").

38 Peter said to them, "Repent, and each one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 For the promise is for you and your children, and for all who are far away, as many as the Lord our God will call to himself." Joel 2:28; Eph 2:13; 40 With many other words he testified and exhorted them saying, "Save yourselves from this perverse generation!" 41 So those who accepted his message were baptized, and that day about three thousand people were added.

42 They were devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. 43 Reverential awe came over everyone, and many wonders and miraculous signs came about by the apostles. Mark 16:17; Acts 5:12; 44 All who believed were together and held everything in common, Deut 15:4; Acts 4:32; 45 and they began selling their property and possessions and distributing the proceeds to everyone, as anyone had need. Isa 58:7; Acts 4:35;

(38) Infant baptism cannot save, since baptism follows repentance. (42) The four activities of the early Church were (1) Bible study (2) fellowship (3) ordinance of the Lord's Supper (4) prayer.

The Holy Spirit adds to the Church those whom He chooses. It is not the work of the Church to increase its membership. (New Testament Study Guide; 2005; Chuck Smith notes; page 56)
