The Jews are also guilty (2:1-29). Paul's frightful picture of man's sinfulness is equally true of the Jews, even though they are God's own nation, for they also practice the sins that are common to humanity. You have no excuse (2:1) includes every one of us. Not that everyone does all the things mentioned in 1:20-31; it is a picture of the human race as a whole. But each one of us is guilty of some of the things mentioned there. The day when God will judge men's secrets (2:16). In that day the test will not be race, not whether one is a Jew or a Gentile, but the inner state of the heart and its attitude toward God and people in everyday life.

God will not only judge a person's actions but also his motivations. He knows the truth about each of us. People mistake God's mercy and long suffering for weakness or indifference to their sin and rebellion. God's goodness, not the threat of judgment and hell, leads a man to repentance. We ask for God's mercy not justice for our sins deserve punishment. God will judge us without regard to our nationality. We'll be judged according to the knowledge that we have God has given every man a conscience, so that he knows good and evil. Rituals will not save us if we're not walking according to God's will, whether we're circumcised, baptized, or members of a church. Obedience to God, not rituals, counts for salvation.

Romans 2:1 teaches us that the things we judge in other people are the very things we do ourselves. The Lord gave a good example to help understand this principle. Why do we do something ourselves and think it was perfectly all right, but judge someone else for doing it? Because we look at ourselves through rose-colored glasses, but we look at everyone else through a magnifying glass. We make excuses for our own behavior, but when someone else behaves exactly the same way, we are often merciless. Doing unto others as we want them to do to us (Matthew 7:12) is a good life principle to follow, one that prevents us from indulging in judgment and criticism. Judgmental thoughts come from a negative mind; a mind that thinks about what is wrong with an individual instead of what is right.

1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal. 2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing. Matt 7:22; Rom 12:7; Matt 17:20; Matt 21:21; Mark 11:23; Luke 17:6; 3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profits me nothing.

4 Charity suffers long, and is kind; charity envies not; charity brags not itself, is not puffed up, Prov 10:12; 1Pet 4:8; 5 Does not behave itself unseemly, seeks not her own, is not easily provoked, thinks no evil; 1Cor 10:24; Phil 2:4; 6 Rejoices not in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; 2John 1:4; 7 Bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

8 Charity never fails: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away. 9 For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. 10 But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away. 11 When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things. 12 For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known. 2Cor 3:18;

13 And now stays faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.


