Scripture

1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. John 8:36; Rom 6:18; Rom 6:22; Gal 5:1; 3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: Acts 13:39; Rom 3:28; Gal 2:16; Heb 7:18; 2Cor 5:21; Gal 3:13; 4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. 5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. 1Cor 2:14; 6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. 7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. 8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God. 9 But you are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Romans 8: 1-11

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26 Likewise the Spirit also helps our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself makes intercession for us with groaning which cannot be uttered. Matt 20:22; Jas 4:3; 27 And he that searches the hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because he makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. 29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. Col 1:18; 30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? Num 14:8; 32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? Gen 22:12; Isa 53:5; John 3:16; 33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifies. Isa 50:8; 34 Who is he that condemns? It is Christ that died, yes rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us. Heb 7:25; 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 As it is written, For your sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Ps 44:22; 1 Cor 4:9; 2 Cor 4:11; 37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8: 26-39

Do your circumstances ever cause you to question God's love for you? Even in the midst of the most difficult of circumstances, God's love is real and active in your life. Nothing can separate us from His love; nothing can ever cause Him to love you less. Cling to God's love for you, and ask Him to keep revealing His love to you.

When condemnation comes against us, we need to quote Romans 8:1; it is a "Word weapon." We do not walk after the flesh, but after the Spirit. Walking after the flesh is depending on yourself, walking after the Spirit is depending on God. So, let go and let God. When we fail, that does not mean we are a failure. It means that we did not do everything right. We have to accept that we have strengths and weaknesses. Let Jesus be strong in your weakness, let Him be your Strength on your weak days, He will carry you. If it is victory you are waiting for and you have not seen it yet, rather than feeling condemned about it, be patient. Walk in the Spirit and do not receive condemnation, that is not from God.....conviction is but not condemnation. Confusion also is not from God, neither is lust or temptation, for God does not tempt or cause lust or confusion, those are all tricks of Satan....remember it says to kill, steal, destroy....if he can get you to believe it, than you are deceived. There is NO peace when the deceiver speaks to us, he cannot give peace. If we try to solve things with our own reasoning we cannot find peace, because according to Romans 8:6 the mind of the flesh is death, the mind of the Holy Spirit is life and peace.

If you have a decision to make submit it to God, first pray, than search the Bible for Scripture pertaining to what you are going through or the decision you have to make; does it line up with the Word?? Do you have peace?? When you know that God has spoken to you, you should wait to act until peace fills your soul to do what He has instructed you to do, so that the timing is His and not yours. Don't go by emotions, they are fickle, let them subside and than decide, it is tuff a lot of times, but you will not regret it. The waiting room sucks, and I was there the last time for 19 years. So don't give up, and don't quit.....for than suddenly....what we forget as humans is His ways are higher than ours and His timing is different than ours, my 19 years, may in God's eyes only have been 19 days (I don't know, I cannot speak for Him on that). I do know the plan He had, I tried to hurry it up, and stepped back into my will and out of His will, His way.....so than....it was hindered.....the flow almost stopped and it was strife, upon strife, hindrances here and there. Instead of letting go and letting God, I TOOK OVER AND WAS DOING IT MY WAY, so I fell out of His will, and a word of caution, He does not have to bless anything that you plan to do or are doing if it is not in His will. So don't think I have this plan, that plan and it is going to turn out this way, but is it God's will?? A person came along beside me, a mentor, and prayed with me, we studied the Bible together, fellow shipped.....and I know God sent that person, as He told me to be expecting that person much like ElishaI waited three years.....and than suddenly.....I felt like my neck was in a noose so much despair and pain.....and all because I did it my way....I than cried out to God.....DELIVER ME, PLEASE and He did. Sometimes He takes our errors and uses them for trials. He turned it into something good for His purpose.

28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. Romans 8:28

Does this mean I did not suffer and have pain? No it doesn't and I suffered a great deal, and am today just becoming back to myself, renewed, and molded as pottery for His purposes. When I say to some I am like cold blue steel, it is the truth; does it mean I don't have a softened heart? No, it doesn't.....He has me like this sometimes as steel for a reason, so I won't flinch...in whatever He has me to do.

So in all this, and as events unfold today, which are foretold in the Bible, what is going on in the world. We can be reminded that Paul suffered greatly during his lifetime; shipwrecks, beatings, that left him near death, abandonment of friends, imprisonment, and execution. Scripture tells us that all will face various forms of suffering in our lives (John 16:33). How can we withstand suffering? Ask God to help us, and have Paul's attitude of confidence that earthly sufferings cannot come close to, compared to the glory we will one day see (Romans 8:18).

Did you know that God did not create us for failure?? We all may fail at some things on our way to success, but we must trust Him.....and He will and can take even our errors and work them out for our good, He can take our mistakes and turn them into miracles, if we continue to trust in Him.

Do you know that Jesus intercedes for us? That He prays for us?....So, go to Him for everything.....and if what you are doing....is not coming out right or not coming to pass...write your prayer down, and read it again and again, have you been praying the wrong way for what you asked for? (Example I was asking for healing for a person, but I did not specify what kind of healing of.....) Does what you are asking for backed up by the Word? Did you ask for His will, and not yours?.....and just maybe there is something wrong with the plan that He knows and you don't, and later you will look back and say aha, that's why?? In the mean time do what was the last thing He gave you to do.....don't skip any steps to speed it up. He does not give us all the steps all at once, most of the time step by step, and some of the things I am doing right now, I had no clue it would be done this way, but it is for His purpose not ours. We are for His glory, not ours....

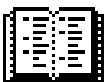
